Using this family of standards will help your organization manage the security of assets such as financial information, intellectual property, employee details or information entrusted to you by third parties.

ISO/IEC 27001 is the best-known standard in the family providing requirements for an information security management system (ISMS).

Course Aims

This two-day course takes an in-depth look at Information Security Management, the applicable legislation and how to implement and audit effective Information Security Management Systems. You will cover the stages of implementing an ISMS and review the requirements of ISO 27001:2013 standard. In addition, there will be syndicate work on developing an implementation plan, information security policy and an ISMS audit plan.

- Have used ISO 19011 to prepare, perform and lead an audit
- Have evaluated and reported audit findings and addressed effective follow-up activities
